

Orchestra Concert Uniform

The way we look as a group on stage says a lot about our self-respect, attention to detail, and our excellence as a group! For this reason, we have a standard concert uniform that all students wear. This uniform will be the required dress for all of our performances (with the exception of our *Fall "Spooktacular" Concert*, at which students have the option to wear either a costume or the concert uniform). When you do not adhere to the uniform, you stick out to the audience, and all eyes are on you! We are one group, one team, one family – and we want to look that way!

Most of these items can be purchased at local discount stores or even thrift stores! We do not ask that parents spend a lot of money on designer brands or on fancy performance uniforms from a catalogue. However, we do ask that you try to follow the guidelines below as closely as possible. Please no black and white patterns, stripes, polka dots, solid white outfits, solid black outfits, flip-flops, crop pants, leggings, short skirts, see-through tops, sleeveless tops, etc.

The simple rule: solid white tops, solid black bottoms!

Ladies:

1. A solid white long-sleeved blouse or solid white long-sleeved button-up shirt.
2. A pair of black dress pants or a knee-length or longer black skirt.
 - Skirts must be accompanied by black tights or dark hosiery
3. Black dress shoes with black socks, stockings, or hosiery.

Gentlemen:

1. A solid white long-sleeved button up shirt.
2. Black dress pants.
3. A dark tie.
4. Black dress shoes with black socks.
